

(description of reasons for liability) :

Madison and Newton are the blocks adjacent to Walteria Elementary School and was and is used by Parents of students attending the elementary school for drop off of elementary age children for school. This intersection was used in that Walteria had inadequate driveways and parking closer to the school to allow for drop off and pick up of students.

Defendants CITY OF TORRANCE, UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT OF TORRANCE and DOES 11 to 50 (hereinafter Municipal Defendants) knew that Parents parked their vehicles at the intersection for purposes of dropping off for school.

The Municipal defendants knew that traffic during rush hour cut through the side streets, which included Madison and Newton, in order to avoid the congestion of the major streets which surround it.

The Municipal defendants knew or should of known that the amount of traffic in this area mandated the use of a crossing guard or at the very least required signage preventing through traffic from using these streets.

As a result of the combination of traffic, the residents trying to get to and from home, and students travelling to and from school this intersection constituted a dangerous condition for students who were attempting to walk to school.

The Municipal Defendants knew of should of known that this was a dangerous condition under Government Code section 835 and as a result of their failure to correct this condition Plaintiff Justin Clift was hit by a car while crossing the street.


